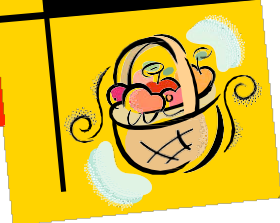

Registration Information

We have four outstanding teachers offering classes on Friday evening and all day Saturday and Sunday. There is something for everyone and for all weaving levels.

Before you register, please read the class descriptions carefully and pay attention to suggested weaving levels, special tools required, and basket size when making your selections. Classes range from four to eight hours.

Your registration form and class selections must be received by June 29 to be considered as a first day registration.

Many classes will fill on the first day, so don't delay. Please read and carefully follow all instructions on the registration form.

You must be a LLBWA member to register. If you are not currently a member, it's not too late to join. Simply add the \$10 for membership dues to your registration fees.

Registration is \$10 for Friday evening, \$20 for Saturday, \$20 for Sunday, or \$45 for the entire weekend.

Meals will be available at the facility Friday evening as well as Saturday and Sunday afternoon and must be pre-ordered. Meal information will be forthcoming with your class assignment confirmation packet.

You will receive your class assignment confirmation packet sometime after June 29. The fees for additional kit orders must be returned by July 31.

There will be no cancellations

or refunds allowed after August 1st. If you must cancel after this date, you will need to have someone pick up your kit(s) from the teacher(s) at Camp Tuck.

Directions to Community Activity Center **1110 Douglas St. Normal, Illinois**

From I-55 Southbound: Take Veterans Parkway Exit 167. Turn left at the stop sign at the end of the ramp. Get in the far right lane and take the Shelbourne/Normal exit on the right. Turn right at the stop sign at the end of the ramp. Continue on Shelbourne to Beech St. Turn left onto Beech Street and go two blocks. Turn left on Lincoln and then turn left on Cole Street. The parking lot is on the right

From I-74 Eastbound: Take Exit 127 toward Chicago and then merge onto I-55 North. Take the N Main St/US 51 S Business Exit 165A toward Bloomington-Normal. Take a left on Raab Road then a right on Linden St. Take a left at Shelbourne Drive then turn right on to Beech St. Turn left on Lincoln St. then left on Cole St. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

From I-74 Westbound: Take I-55 N/US 51 N. Take the N Main St/US 51 S Business Exit 165A toward Bloomington-Normal. Take a left on Raab Road then a right on Linden St. Take a left at Shelbourne Drive then turn right on to Beech St. Turn left on Lincoln St. then left on Cole St. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

From I-39 Southbound: Merge onto I-55 N via exit left toward Chicago. Take the N Main St/US 51 S Business Exit 165A toward Bloomington-Normal. Take a left on Raab Road then a right on Linden St. Take a left at Shelbourne Drive then turn right on to Beech St. Turn left on Lincoln St. then left on Cole St. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

From US 51 Northbound: Merge onto US 51 N toward Peoria/Rockford and stay straight on I-55 N. Take the N Main St/US 51 S Business Exit 165A toward Bloomington-Normal. Take a left on Raab Road then a right on Linden St. Take a left at Shelbourne Drive then turn right on to Beech St. Turn left on Lincoln St. then left on Cole St. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

Please Note: There are a limited number of handicapped parking spaces in front of the Activity Center.

WEAVING LEVELS

Beginner:

Student has little or no weaving experience with materials or technique used.

Intermediate:

Skilled in basic technique and materials used. Weaver has no trouble setting up bases, twining, over/under weaving and rims using the material of the class offered.

Advanced:

Mastered all basic and intermediate skills for materials and techniques used. This class is more challenging.

All Levels:

Classes offered to all student skill levels from Beginner to Advanced.

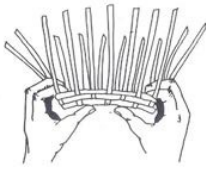

The Land of Lincoln Basket Weavers Association Camp Tuck-A-Basket will be held September 6-8, 2024, at the Community Activity Center in Normal, Illinois.

Anyone wishing to sell in the Vendor area must be an LLBWA Camp Tuck-A-Basket 2024 teacher or a current member.

Vending will take place in the same building that the classes will be held in, at the Community Activity Center. Lodging is available at nearby hotels. Contact information for lodging is in the Camp Tuck brochure. (Let me know if you need that information.)

One table for each vendor will be provided this year. Vendors will be responsible for bringing any additional equipment necessary for set up.

Vending Fee There is no vending fee for this year for the first space. Spaces are 10 x 10. You may have multiple spaces but each additional 10 x 10 space will be \$10. Just indicate the number of spaces you would like on the vendor application.

Vendor set up time begins Friday, September 6, 2024, at 12:30 pm.

Friday Evening Classes

Class: SUMNER

Instructor: SUSAN BAXTER

Class Length: 4 HOURS

Weaving Level: ALL

Class Fee: \$50

Description: Sumner is based on a 4" acrylic bloom base and introduces some of the "FUN"amentals of round reed weaving. Twining is used to secure the spokes and then 3-rod wale takes the stage. Using different colored reed will produce a "becoming" design on the sides. How color and spoke count can create different designs will be discussed as well as the flexibility of round reed borders. The basket is a great size for keys, remotes, fruit or anything that has a tendency to "get lost".

Special Tools: BENT- NOSE PLIERS

Dimensions: Height: 3.3" Diameter 7.3"



Class: SOLID WRAP TURKEY WING

Instructor: JEANNE DUDLEY

Class Length: 4 Hours

Weaving Levels: All Levels

Class Fee: \$49

Description: Description: The student will learn to tie a turkey wing whisk broom—by solid wrapping each addition of broom straw to completion of the solid whisk broom's handle. Many colors of broom straw or all natural straw will be available to choose from—as well as many colors of broom string to highlight the whisk broom. Beautiful to use and Beautiful to hang on your wall or fireplace.

Special Tools: All tools provided by the teacher

Dimensions: 24" – 30"



Friday Evening Classes

Class: KAREN'S TOTE

Instructor: MARJORIE KENNEDY

Class Length: 4 Hours

Weaving Level: All Levels

Class Fee: \$42

Description: A great chairside basket that has a woven base, natural and dyed weavers, basket feet and a wrapped handle that are woven on a D handle. Color choices are Black, Navy, Dk. Green and Burgundy.

Dimensions: Width: 8 ½" Length: 10" Height: 16"



Class: THINKING OF YOU

Instructor: JULIE KLEINRATH

Class Length: 4 Hours

Weaving Levels: All Levels

Class Fee: \$45

Description: Woven on an oval wood base, learn to add an overlay color to both the spokes and weavers. The basket is finished with a bushel handle and a flower embellishment made by the instructor.

Dimensions: Width: 8" x 5" deep.



SATURDAY CLASSES

Class: DELLA

Instructor: SUSAN BAXTER

Class Length: 8 HOURS

Weaving Level: INTERMEDIATE

Class Fee: \$75

Description: Della starts with a 5” slotted acrylic bloom base that uses #2 round reed twining to secure the #4 spokes. The sides are woven with a 3-rod wale that creates a spiral design called “becoming”. A twine arrow is used to help with the border spacing. The double diagonal rim creates a dramatic statement that is not only beautiful but incredibly strong. Care must be taken to ensure correct shaping and spoke placement within the border.



Dimensions: Height: 3.75” Diameter: 9”

Class: SPOONER WHISK BROOM

Instructor: JEANNE DUDLEY

Class Length: 6 HOURS

Weaving Level: ALL

Class Fee: \$59.00

Description: Utilizing an actual wooden kitchen utensil or a gnarly wooden stick as the handle, the student will use natural and dyed broom corn to construct a kitchen whisk broom that is useful. Plaiting and sewing the broom will be learned in class. Various colors will be available. All of the plaiting will be done with the broom stalk strips with lots of colored cords to choose from.



SPECIAL TOOLS: Teacher will provide all tools needed for this class.

SATURDAY CLASSES

Class: FESTIVE

Instructor: MARJORIE KENNEDY

Class Length: 8 hours

Weaving Level: ALL

Class Fee: \$65

Description: Placement of dyed weavers and spokes on a wooden base create the pattern for this basket. Attention will be given to weaving tension and shaping. Colors are navy, burgundy, and mustard. Dk green may be chosen for navy.

HEIGHT: 10"**



Class: FLAT EGG BASKET

Instructor: JULIE KLEINRATH

Class Length: 6-8 hours

Weaving Level: Intermediate

Special Tools: WEAVING TOOLS

**Class Fee: \$75
ADDITIONAL KITS \$60**

Description: Woven so the basket will fit between a screen door and inside door. The handle has been braided with leather lacing. The design on the sides as well as the "rim" are also woven with leather lacing.

Dimensions: 12" Diameter x 2 1/2" deep



Sunday Classes

Class: VESTA

Instructor: SUSAN BAXTER

Class Length: 6 Hours

Weaving Level: Intermediate

Class Fee: \$ 60

Description: Vesta combines a number of round reed techniques with Reed for a unique look. The basket starts with a 3D Star Jig to create an Open base with equally spaced spokes. Twining, 3-rod wale, and a flat Reed twill do the heavy lifting, allowing the weaver time to learn how to Create a footer with inserted spokes. The excitement continues by using These additional spokes for a new take on a traditional style border. Sp jigs will be available for purchase after project completion.

Special Tools: Bent-nose pliers, 3D printed Star Jig will be provided for class duration

Dimensions: Height: 3.25" Diameter: 7.25"



Class: KITCHEN BROOM

Instructor: JEANNE DUDLEY

Class Length: 4 Hours

Weaving Level: All Levels

Class Fee: \$65

Description: Utilizing a sassafras stick, students will use natural broom corn to construct a kitchen broom that is totally useful. The broom straw will be tied totally with wire in a decorative style. Stitching the broom will be taught in this class. Bring a special stick or hard wood or choose one from Jeanne's supply. (1/2"-1" diameter, 26"-42" long)

Hand carved Spirit of the woods Sassafras stick is a \$25.00 additional cost.

Special Tools: All broom tools will be furnished by the teacher.

Dimensions: 48" -52" long



Sunday Classes

Class: BASKET OF PLENTY

Instructor: MARJORIE KENNEDY

Class Length: 6 Hours

Weaving Level: ALL

Class Fee: \$55

Description: Shaping and weaving tension are observed while weaving this basket on a wooden base with leather handles.

Special Tools: none

Dimensions: Width: HEIGHT: 9 ½" Diameter: 14"



Class: CRISS CROSS APPLESAUCE

Instructor: JULIE KLEINRATH

Class Length: 6 Hours

Weaving Level: Intermediate

Class Fee: \$60

ADDITIONAL KITS ARE \$40

Description: Woven on a round wood base in natural with smoke crosses surrounded by chain waling in dyed reed. The basket is finished with waxed linen lashing

Special Tools: none

Dimensions: Diameter; 13"x 9 ½" High, with handles 12" high
