Registration Information

We have four outstanding teachers offering classes on Friday evening and all day Saturday and Sunday. There is something for everyone and for all weaving levels.

Before you register, please read the class descriptions carefully and pay attention to suggested weaving levels, special tools required, and basket size when making your selections. Classes range from four to eight hours.

Your registration form and class selections must be received by June 28 to be considered as a first day registration.

Many classes will fill on the first day, so don't delay. Please read and carefully follow all instructions on the registration form.

You must be a LLBWA member to register. If you are not currently a member, it's not too late to join. Simply add the \$10 for membership dues to your registration fees.

Registration is \$10 for Friday evening, \$20 for Saturday, \$20 for Sunday, or \$45 for the entire weekend.

Meals will be available at the facility Friday evening as well as Saturday and Sunday afternoon and must be preordered. Meal information will be forthcoming with your class assignment confirmation packet.

You will receive your class assignment confirmation packet sometime after June 29. The fees for additional kit orders must be returned by July 31.

There will be no cancellations or refunds allowed after August 1st. If you must cancel after this date, you will need to have someone pick up your kit(s) from the teacher(s) at Camp Tuck.

Beginner:

Student has little or no weaving experience with materials or technique used.

Intermediate:

Skilled in basic technique and materials used. Weaver has no trouble setting up bases, twining, over/under weaving and rims using the material of the class offered.

Advanced:

Mastered all basic and intermediate skills for materials and techniques used. His class is more challenging.

All Levels:

Classes offered to all student skill levels from Beginner to Advanced.



<u>Directions to Community Activity Center</u> 1110 Douglas St. Normal, Illinois

From I-55 Southbound: Take Veterans Parkway Exit 167. Turn left at the stop sign at the end of the ramp. Get in the far right lane and take the Shelbourne/Normal exit on the right. Turn right at the stop sign at the end of the ramp. Continue on Shelbourne to Beech \(\) Turn left onto Beech Street and go two blocks. Turn left on Lincoln and then turn left on Cole Street. The parking lot is on the right

From I-74 Eastbound: Take Exit 127 toward Chicago and then merge onto I-55 North. Take the N Main St/US 51 S Business Exit 165A toward Bloomington-Normal. Take a left on Raab Road then a right on Linden St. Take a left at Shelbourne Drive then turn right on to Beech St. Turn left on Lincoln St. then left on Cole St. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

From I-74 Westbound: Take I-55 N/US 51 N. Take the N Main St/US 51 S Business Exit 165A toward Bloomington-Normal. Take a left on Raab Road then a right on Linden St. Take a left at Shelbourne Drive then turn right on to Beech St. Turn left on Lincoln St. then left on Cole St. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

From I-39 Southbound: Merge onto I-55 N via exit left toward Chicago. Take the N Main St/US 51 S Business Exit 165A toward Bloomington-Normal. Take a left on Raab Road then a right on Linden St. Take a left at Shelbourne Drive then turn right on to Beech St. Turn left on Lincoln St. then left on Cole St. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

From US 51 Nortbound: Merge onto US 51 N toward Peoria/Rockford and stay straight on I-55 N. Take the N Main St/US 51 S Business Exit 165A toward Bloomington-Normal. Take a left on Raab Road then a right on Linden St. Take a left at Shelbourne Drive then turn right on to Beech St. Turn left on Lincoln St. then left on Cole St. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

Please Note: There are a limited number of handicapped parking spaces in front of the Activity Center.

Volunteer Today for Camp Tuck!



Anyone wishing to sell in the Vendor area must be an LLBWA Camp Tuck-A-Basket 2025 teacher or a current member.

Vending will take place in the same building that the classes will be held in, at the Community Activity Center. Lodging is available at nearby hotels. Contact information for lodging is in the Camp Tuck brochure. (Let me know if you need that information.)

One table for each vendor will be provided this year. Vendors will be responsible for bringing any additional equipment necessary for set up.

<u>Vending Fee</u> There is no vending fee for this year for the first space. Spaces are 10×10 . You may have multiple spaces but each additional 10×10 space will be \$10. Just indicate the number of spaces you would like on the vendor application.

Vendor set up time begins Friday, September 5, 2025, at 12:30 pm.

CLASS: TREE OF LIFE PENDANT

INSTRUCTOR: SANDY BULGRIN

CLASS LENGTH: 3 Hours WEAVING LEVEL: All

CLASS FEE: \$28

DESCRIPTION:

Students will use wire and a mold to make a frame. Beads and wire will be used to make the

tree of life. Each one unique with the choices of wire; copper, silver, gold, and rose gold, plus many assorted bead combinations. A fun project that you will be wearing at the end of class and will want to make more for family and friends.

DIMENSIONS: Diameter: 21/2"

CLASS: SUEDE HANDLE SHELF BASKET

INSTRUCTOR: PAT MERCER CLASS LENGTH: 4 HOURS WEAVING LEVEL: ALL

CLASS FEE: \$49

DESCRIPTIONS:

This practical shelf basket is both sturdy and attractive. From a woven base the basket rises

via start/stop weave and twining. The diamond embellishments on each side are woven into the basket rather than being added later. The cut out handles are finished on the sides and wrapped in suede at the rim. Participants may elect to add an optional butterfly knot on top of each handle. A tapestry needle will be provided.

SPECIAL TOOLS: Basic weaver's tools and spoke weights DIMENSIONS: Width: 9½" Length: 11½" Height: 6½"

CLASS: ADORNMENT

INSTRUCTOR: PAM PHILPOTT

CLASS LENGTH: 4 hours WEAVING LEVEL: All

CLASS FEE: \$50

DESCRIPTION: The main objective will be to cover a plastic ring with thread using a buttonhole stitch then add three rows of pine needle coils to make an adornment. Students

will be given the option of thread and bead color, and other embellishments to add to their adornment. One adornment completed in class plus materials for a second adornment.

SPECIAL TOOLS: small sharp snips and small needle nose jewelry pliers.

DIMENSIONS: 3"

CLASS: ENCHANTING SPARKLE JAR

INSTRUCTOR: LORALEE ROBERTS

CLASS LENGTH: 4 Hours WEAVING LEVEL: All Levels

DESCRIPTION: The unique combination of

plastic lace and cane make this jar come to life.

Learn the Japanese weave and a folded rim. Color choices available.

INSTRUCTOR: SANDY BULGRIN

CLASS LENGTH: 8 Hours

DESCRIPTION: A great addition to your home plus this is your chance to learn how to do the seven-step caning, on a foot stool that is made for caning. The frame is finished in a light stain. 12 caning pegs are included in the class.

CLASS: DEEPER INTO THE GARDEN

INSTRUCTOR: PAM MERCER

DESCRIPTION: Built on a 5" x 14" D handle, the base of this basket measures 6" wide and grows to @ 11 "

through diligent attention to shaping. Starts with stop and start weaving but most of the basket is woven in opposing chase weave and turn backs. A double single braid provides a delicate-looking rim while a wrapped handle completes the look.

SPECIAL TOOLS: several awls helps but not necessary DIMENSIONS: Width: 6-11", Length: 5", Height: @9"

CLASS: Ceramic Pine Bowl Instructor: Pam Philpott CLASS LENGTH: 8 hours

WEAVING LEVEL: All

CLASS FEE: \$60



DESCRIPTION: Participants will be provided a ceramic bowl, long leaf pine needles waxed sinew, and wood beads to complete the project. Beginners will learn to keep tight tension in the stitches and learn the simple spiral stitch. Intermediate and advanced weavers will be taught the spiral wheat stitch and the technique to add wooden beads between the coils. Optional thread colors will be available.

DESCRIPTION: Get in the holiday spirit with this beautiful round basket woven on a 5" wood base. Learn to make a rim with round reed and to place crossing curls on your basket.

DESCRIPTION: This basket base is started with round reed spokes and is wove in a rand and Japanese pattern. Students will learn to weave a foot on the base. The sides are twined with round reed and sea grass. The basket is finished off with a braided border. Students will create their own shape as a vessel or a bowl.

DIMENSIONS: Height: 6" Diameter: 7"

CLASS: GIVE IT A TWIST

INSTRUCTOR: PAT MERCER CLASS LENGTH: 6 Hours

WEAVING LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

CLASS FEE: \$66



DESCRIPTION: This tote incorporates spiral

macrame with basket weaving. The solid woven base

made possible by twin fillers, keeps the tote light for comfortable, all day use. The walls are stop/start weave and triple twined arrows. The macrame spirals are started before the basket is finished but may be completed later after class. The webbed handles are attached by a no sew method and the rim filler is a color coordinated, decorative fiber-covered cord.

made into a wearable necklace with leather strap. The basket will be started without a base and will require a great deal of finger dexterity, experience in maintaining a coil and tight stitching. Therefore, it is for highly experienced and advanced coilers. Variety of threads, beads and a charm to individualize your amulet.

SPECIAL TOOLS: small sharp snips, small needle nose jewelry pliers

DIMENSIONS: Width: 1" Length: 2" Height: 2.5"

DESCRIPTION: This is a great solid bottom market with the colors for Fall. You will learn how to use fillers, chicken feet, and triple twine.

DIMENSIONS:
